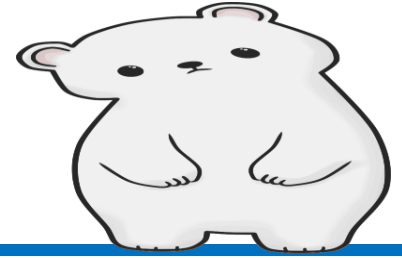

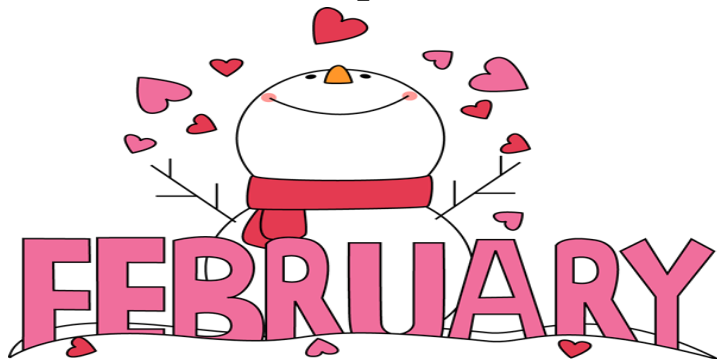
"New Year, New Goals, New Growth!"
